

Beacon. The switched-on app for families online.


The partnership between these two iconic West Australian organisations brings together 15 years of cyber behaviour research by scientists at the Telethon Kids Institute and digital expertise and research by Bankwest. This research found Australian adults were concerned about their children's cyber behaviour, overwhelmed with amount of information online and its credibility, and wanted to learn more so they could provide the right support.

Beacon aims to improve the digital future for Australian children by building parents' and carers' digital skills so they can confidently navigate their children's use of digital technology in a positive way and minimise potential harms associated with being online.

The Beacon app integrates seamlessly into parents' daily lives, delivering the most trusted and up-to-date information backed by behavioural science research, as well as personalised support, ideas and strategies at their fingertips to navigate the ever-changing online world.








The cyber safety research

For the first time, we are now witnessing a generation of children who have had ready access to digital technologies since birth, and no memory of life before the Internet. This creates both opportunities and challenges.

Digital literacy, skills, and citizenship



The cyber safety research

Our research shows that parents play a critical role in helping to develop the digital skills of their children and encouraging them to use technology in a positive and safe way. Therefore, it is crucial that parents are supported to build their own capabilities to help navigate the ever-changing technology landscape to help teach and guide their children.



The online challenges

With great opportunity also comes with challenges. Our research has identified a number of challenges increasingly facing families.

Lifestyle risks

The physical health risks associated with sedentary lifestyle and screen-based media use

Content risks

Exposure to potentially harmful or incorrect information.

Contact risks

Potentially harmful interactive behaviours such as cyberbullying and impact on mental health

Conduct risks

Online actions
that put users
at risk such as
downloading illegal
content

Privacy risks

Online risks to users' personal data.




